ASB community members present the net proceeds of the Sukhumvit Fair 2010 to the Prostheses Foundation of HRH The Princess Mother and to the Green World Foundation On Tuesday, March 30th 2010. A group of ASB administrators, staff and students went to the Prostheses Foundation of HRH The Princess Mother of Thailand and the Green World Foundation, to donate the funds raised from Sukhumvit Fair 2010 to these organizations. The day started with a visit to the Prostheses Foundation, a non-profit organization whose main aim is to provide free artificial legs for amputees, regardless of nationality or religion. Upon arrival, ASB community members were welcomed by the honorable committee member of the Prostheses Foundation Dr. Chalernbongse Komarakul. He expressed his appreciation to the school for its generosity. He also provided an update of the activities of the Foundation. The American School of Bangkok donated 100,000 Baht to this Foundation. ASB Dance Team

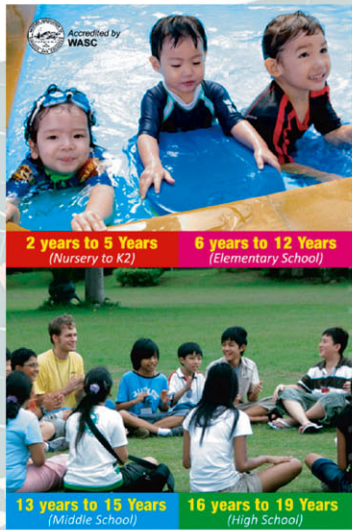
